



2. That the office of the Trust shall be situated at West to Sahara India/P.O:-Barbigha, Distt-Sheikhpura, or at any other place as the Board of Trustees may decide from time to time.
3. It will operate for the welfare & utility of public and termed as public charitable Trust.
4. That the object for which the Trust is created are:

- a. National unity and International peace and amity. Promote Education without distinguishing on caste, colour, religion and sex basis, by providing them primary, secondary as well as advance education, growth oriented ambience, exposure, appropriate training under supervision of qualified faculty with a view to bring them in real asset for society and country through DIVINE LIGHT PUBLIC SCHOOL & its branches time to time after discussion from Trustees for
EDUCATION FOR ALL
- b. Communal and social harmony and brotherhood.
- c. Promotion and extension of appropriate technology including systems having renewable sources of energy.
- d. To take up programmes for ensuring protection of environment and also.
- e. For regeneration of natural resources degraded due to our past neglects.



- e. To start, maintain and assist any relief measures in those parts which are or become subjected to natural calamities such as Floods, Fire, Drought, Famine, Cyclone, Earthquake, Storm Accident etc.
- g. Promotion of cottage and small scale industries by taking up action research work.
- h. Promotion and progress of agriculture and animal husbandry.
- i. To undertake evaluation of economic and social projects.
- j. To take up programmes in which Science and Technology may have major role in improving life, working conditions and opportunities for gainful employment of women and socially weaker section, to work for economic development of the poor sections of the Society for eradication of poverty, illiteracy, injustice, deprivation and backwardness to take up enforcement of prohibition and initiate people's movement against smoking, alcoholism and drug abuse.
- k. To take up programmes for accelerating pace of rural development by application of science and technology (techniques and technologies for cost reduction, improving productivity etc.) specially in the field of water exploration, watershed and purification, sanitation, low cost housing, agriculture and animal husbandry and engineering sources.

Propagation and promotion of work centres and co-operation of any kind or others and giving organizations etc. in the furtherance of the objects of organization.



- m. To undertake programmes which ensures raising of income levels and expanding employment opportunities of the weaker sections of society specially of those leaving below poverty lines and women by involving participants in the planning, implementation and maintenance of activities taken up. To give, provide training for better and modern/up-to-date Technical farming, Fisheries, Poultry farming, Animal husbandry, Horticulture Training of Handicrafts, Fine arts and other useful arts, crafts including the establishment and maintenance of Shilpa-Shikshalayas, Kala-Kendras and other small industries by virtue of which people fight against poverty by self-employment.
- n. To take up all formal and non formal education programme.
- o. To undertake basic research in the areas of health, education and family welfare.
- p. To undertake implement able activities related to the stated areas by creating network of sub-offices at various geographical locations, if required.
- q. To undertake training and educational campaigns as part of strategic implementation plan.
- r. To undertake activities that are oriented towards the promotion of family welfare, including the delivery of family welfare services.
- s. To encourage people specially women and those belonging to weaker sections to develop the livelihood, income and employment generating opportunities and activities by taking up various income generation schemes like fisheries, dairy, agriculture, floriculture, horticulture, cottage and small industries, vending in the form of SHG's.
- t. To set up educational facilities for girls, minorities, SC, ST, OBC's and other weaker sections of the society.

- u. To set up old age home, orphanage, reform homes for socially neglected children and women etc.
- v. To raise or acquire funds or property from central government, state government, foreign agencies, non-government agencies, charitable trusts by way of donations or grants or contributions or by taking loan from public and private financial institutions. The funds, properties, assets and all other resources, present and future, of the society shall be utilised for any or all the purpose or objects of the society as stated above and also for similar activities in furtherance of ideals of truth and non violence.
- w. To promote and advertise various systems of medicines.
- x. To organise various kinds of professional and vocational education programmes for unemployed persons.
- y. To organise seminars, conference, meetings etc. on human rights specially women's right.
- z. To work for the welfare of Consumers and protect their rights.

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5. Funds

(Trustees are hereby further empowered to collect donations from Government, Public, Public Undertaking and other persons in the manner they desire.)



That the accounting year of the Trust will be from April to March every year and the first accounts of the Trust shall close on 31st March, 2013. That the Trustees are empowered to appoint a Chartered Accountant for audit of the accounts of the Trust and to fix their remuneration of such auditors. That the accounts so prepared and audited shall be placed before the Special Meeting of the Trustees within three months of the closure of the accounts along with the report of the Auditors. That the accounts so audited shall be printed and published and may be sent to donors of the Trust and the Trustees.

8. Trust meetings

That the Trustees shall meet every quarter for the purpose of the Trust and taking for the management of the Trust and its funds. That the decisions are to be taken by majority. That personal presence of five Trustees will be the quorum for a meeting, convened by a short notice of 12 hours.

9. Special meetings

That the Trust will have in a year its special meetings before 30th June of every year in which the audited accounts of the Trust are to be placed before the special Meeting of the Trustees..... to approve and adopt such accounts and the report, but for the ensuing year shall also be led before the meeting.

10. Investments

That the funds collected for the Trust shall be utilised for carrying out the Trust or acquiring the capital assets or constructing the building, etc., for the purpose of the Trust.

That in case any surplus remain with the Trust the same will be invested in the Government Securities permitted for the Trust or to remain in the Bank in F.D. or S.B. Accounts.

11. Nature of trust

That the nature of the Trust is Public Charitable Trust and the benefit of the Trust shall be available to the beneficiaries without any distinction of cast, creed, religion or sex.

12. Amendment in trust deed

That the Trust Deed can be amended by two-thirds majority of the Trustees in a meeting specially called for the purpose by giving 14 days notice for the purpose and the resolution passed by such majority as circulated with or without notification shall be final and binding for good for his Deed.

13. Powers of the Trustees

That overall control of the trust shall be in the Trustees who will exercise their powers and control through the Executive Committee of the Trustees appointed by them for the purpose or through the office bearers elected by themselves out of them.

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That the Executive Committee or Office bearers shall have the following powers in general:-

15. Chairman

That the Chairman of the Trust will be the virtual Head of the Trustees and will preside over all the meeting of the Trust. The settlor shall be the chairman of Board of trustees as well as chairman of the executive committee. In the event of vacancy of the chairman caused by the death, resignation or otherwise the remaining trustees shall elect as chairman from amongst themselves a candidate who gets the highest number of votes of the trustees present and voting of a meeting specially called for the purpose. The Chairman so elected shall hold office for the period for five years. However, The chairman so elected shall be eligible for re-election.

16. Vice-Chairman

The Vice-Chairman of the Trust shall act in the absence of the Chairman and in his absence all meeting are to be preside by the Vice-Chairman. In case of the absence of the Vice-Chairman also the Trustees are empowered to elect anyone out of them to preside over the meeting. The vice-Chairman shall be nominated by the Chairman for a period of five years with the consultation of trustees from amongst the board of trustees. The Vice chairman shall be eligible for renomination. The Vice-Chairman shall assist the chairman in discharging his duties and do the duties as assigned to him by the chairman from time to time.

17. Managing Trustee

The Board of Trustees are empowered to elect a Managing Trustee of themselves to manage the affairs of the Trust and to look after its day-to-day business. All records of this trust shall remain in the custody of the secretary. The Managing Trustee is entitled to call for the meeting of the Trust under the permission of the Chairman. The Managing Trustee shall be empowered to represent Trust in all cases court of authorities.

The Managing Trustee shall prepare the Annual Report of the Trust and place the same before the Board of Trustees.

18. Treasurer

That out of Trustees, the Trustees are empowered to elect one Treasurer for holding the office for a period of five years. The Treasurer shall be responsible for keeping all records and maintain the account of all receipt and payments. He will be required to prepare the annual budget of the Trust and will place it before the special meeting of the Trust for the approval. The Treasurer will also be required to prepare the final accounts to get the same audited by the Auditors appointed by the Board of Trustees and will place the same before the special meeting of the Trustees.



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19. *Winding up*

That the Trust can wind up its affairs if it finds it difficult to run the activities of the Trust any more but no part of the funds of the Trust and its property shall back to the Trustees.

That the Board of Trustees shall call an extra ordinary meeting of the Trustees for the purpose by giving 14 days notice of the Trustees and a resolution passed by two thirds majority of the Trustees present shall be the requirement for the winding of the Trust.

General:-

The property of the trust whether movable or immovable shall be vested in the Board of Trustees.

a) The number of Executive members of the Executive Committee may be increased, if necessary, by two thirds majority of the Board of Trustees, present and voting in a meeting especially called for the purpose.

b) The Executive Committee shall have the power to frame bye-laws of the trust in respect of any institution of committee set up by the Trust and in respect of any matter within the jurisdiction of the trust.

c) The Executive Committee shall be competent to affiliate other organisation/institution on such terms and conditions as approved by the Board of Trustees.

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- d) The quorum of any meeting of the Board of Trustees, Executive Committee or any committee or sub-committee shall be one-third of member. If the quorum is not complete, the meeting shall be adjourned and reconvened by the Chairman. There shall be no quorum for the adjourned meeting.
- e) The Executive Committee shall be competent to open branches, offices of institution/ outside Barbigha.
- f) Any member of the Trust or Executive Committee or any office bearer may resign at any time from the office or membership held by him/her by writing to the Chairman. The Chairman may address his resignation to the Executive Committee through the secretary of the Trust. The resignation of tendered shall become effective from the date it is accepted by the Executive Committee.
- g) The Executive Committee shall open or caused to be open Bank Account/accounts in the name of the Trust in a schedule in the name of the Trust in a scheduled Bank/Banks. All such accounts shall be operated by the signatures of any two of the Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer, the chairman being always one of them.
- h) The financial year of the Trust for the purpose of maintaining and closing accounts and for the purpose of budget shall commence from the month of April and end with the month of March every calendar year.
- i) All deeds and other documents to be executed by or on behalf of the Trust shall be done, by the Chairman and the Trust may be sued in the name of the Chairman of the Trust. All pleadings including plaints, written statements, counter affidavits, applications, petitions,
